Application(s) must include responses to each of the following criteria:

1. Submit a brief description of your past and present employment history, education and honors. Write about any additional experience you may have that involves the child support profession.

2. On a separate sheet, please write a paragraph about each of the following:
- Describe your experiences working in the child support field;
 - Describe why you are furthering your education;
 - How your degree will support your future plans;
 - Why you have chosen this particular career path; and
 - Describe why you became an MCSEA member.

3. On another sheet, write a 1-2 page essay on the following thoughts: ***If you had the power to change three things in your community or in the world, what would you change and why?***

1. Please state the MCSEA member that you are related to, and what relation are you to him/her.

2. Submit a brief description of your past and present employment history, education and honors. Write about any additional experience you may have that has had an impact on the life of a child or children.

3. On a separate sheet, please write a paragraph about each of the following:
- Describe why you are furthering your education;
 - How your degree will support your future plans; and
 - Why you have chosen this particular path.

4. On another sheet, write a 1-2 page essay on the following thoughts: ***If you had the power to change three things in your community or in the world, what would you change and why?***
